Training to Assess the Competency of Someone to Administer Medication

**How do you ensure
that you are able to assess your staff?**

This 'One-off' training workshop offers you the limited opportunity to attend a one day course which, on successful completion, will provide you with certification to assess staff competency.

CQC Outcome 9 - Management of Medicines States that:-

Where people who use services, receive care, treatment and support that involves medicines, the provider ensures that staff handling medicines have the competency and skills needed to do so safely.

Who is this training aimed at?

This training is aimed at **RGN's and Senior Carers** with a role in training and assessing staff competency to administer medication.

What are the entry Requirements?

Nurses/Carers trained and experienced in administering medication i.e. have attended a Foundation Workshop (e.g. "The Safe Handling of Medicines" or "Medication in care") or equivalent training in the last three years.

What are the contents of the course?

Attendees will cover:

- * How to safely administer medication
- * How to observe and assess staff administering medication

There will be a workbook to use as a part of the training.

Locally developed competency check list and tool kits will also be used as a part of the training.
